

Re: Purple Band Program

STEO is excited to again be coordinating **The Purple Band Program** for junior and senior kindergarten students.

The Purple Band Program provides an efficient means to help protect our tiniest travelers – our junior and senior kindergarten



The Purple Band lets bus drivers easily identify junior and senior kindergarten students with a glance. The purple band is a quick visual tool that reminds bus drivers that the student with a tagged backpack needs their special attention, as well as guardian supervision at the drop-off point.





School Personnel are key in ensuring that all students who should be tagged are. They will attach the purple bands to the school bags of students in the Purple Band Program.

Parents and guardians can assist in STEO's efforts to maintain high standards of safety by adhering to the following: junior and senior kindergarten students must be accompanied to and from the bus stop by a responsible guardian. If nobody is present to meet the student at the bus stop, drivers are directed to take the student back to school with safety in mind.

Parental duties include:

- ▶ Ensuring the purple band is in place on their child's backpack;
- ▶ Ensuring the school has the correct and up-to-date contact and caregiver information;
- ▶ Ensuring that they or a responsible designate are at the school bus stop on time to receive the student;
- ▶ Contacting the school and bus contractor prior to the student boarding the bus if they are unable to provide supervision at the stop and have made alternate arrangements.

STEO assumes the coordination role in The Purple Band Program, bringing all of the pieces together to form a coherent, consistent system. STEO's responsibilities include offering support to guardians, bus contractors and schools in the effective delivery of The Purple Band Program.
