



## School and Transportation Information is only a Click or Call Away...

You can access STEO's transportation information and guidelines for students and parents at [www.steo.ca](http://www.steo.ca) under student information.

### Find My Bus Stop . . . Bus Stop Finder

Accessing busing information is easy. Simply access **Student Transportation of Eastern Ontario's (STEO) Website** at [www.steo.ca](http://www.steo.ca), click on "Find My Bus Stop" button.

Fill in the required information to access your child(ren)'s route number, pickup time and location, operator name and phone number. You can verify busing information after **August 13, 2018**.

### Busing Hotline Phone Number . . .

STEO makes it easy for parents to check on their child(ren)'s transportation information via a **Busing Hotline Number: 1-855-441-1589** from **August 20** until **September 7, 2018**.

### School Eligibility . . .

The **School Eligibility** tool (formerly called School Locator) is now active for the **2018-2019** school year.


The tool can be accessed from the [www.steo.ca](http://www.steo.ca) website by clicking on the **School Eligibility** link – representative icon below.



Pick the 2018-2019 School Year (highlighted in light blue in the screen clip below) before clicking on "School Information", "Which School do I attend?" or "Transportation Eligibility".

- **School Information:** provides the address, phone number, website, boundary map and available programs for a chosen school.
- **Which School do I Attend?** Allows a student/parent/guardian to check for the school eligibility based on any given address entered.

**Transportation Eligibility:** Allows a student/parent/guardian to check whether or not a specified address is eligible (in bounds) for transportation.

To change the **School Year** from within any of the options, click on the HOME menu option and re-select the appropriate **School Year** from the drop down list.

**Note:** The 2018-2019 Parent Portal (aka FIND MY BUS STOP...BUS STOP FINDER) **will not** be active until August 13, 2018. The Parent Portal is used by students/parents/guardians to ascertain pick up and drop off information after routes have been created. The Parent Portal also allows for email subscription for delays and cancellations. After August 13, 2018, updates may occur until the start of school year as changes and updates for transportation and routes are updated daily.

Please check back frequently for updates after August 13, 2018.
