Student Transportation of Eastern Ontario (STEO) recognizes that the safety of all students is the highest priority and believes that contracted transportation service providers and school administration staff share in that responsibility.

STEO shall comply with Ontario Legislation Bill 3, 2005 (*An Act to Protect Anaphylactic Pupils*, also known as Sabrina's Law 2005).

Information regarding identified students with life-threatening medical conditions and/or life-threatening allergies shall be shared with contracted transportation service providers annually in accordance with procedures established by STEO.

STEO shall support Member School Board's policies relating to students with life-threatening medical conditions and/or allergies, including the administration of prescribed medication to students with life-threatening medical conditions requiring the use of an epinephrine auto-injector, where those policies do not contravene established STEO policy.
