Find My Bus Stop . . . Bus Stop Finder

Accessing busing information is easy. Simply access **Student Transportation of Eastern Ontario's (STEO) Website** at www.steo.ca, click on "Find My Bus Stop" button.

Fill in the required information to access your child(ren)'s route number, pickup time and location, operator name and phone number. You can verify busing information after **August 17, 2020**.

School and Transportation Eligibility . . .

The **School and Transportation Eligibility** tool is now active for the **2020-2021** school year.

Pick the 2020-2021 School Year (highlighted in light blue in the screen clip below) before clicking on "School Information", "School Eligibility Which School do I attend?" or "Transportation Eligibility".

- **School Information:** provides the address, phone number, website, boundary map and available programs for a chosen school.
- **School Eligibility Which School do I Attend?** Allows a student/parent/guardian to check for the school eligibility based on any given address entered.

Transportation Eligibility: Allows a student/parent/guardian to check whether or not a specified address is eligible (in bounds) for transportation.

Note: The 2020-2021 Parent Portal (aka FIND MY BUS STOP...BUS STOP FINDER) **will not** be active until August 17, 2020. The Parent Portal is used by students/parents/guardians to check pick up and drop off information after routes have been created. The Parent Portal also allows for email subscription for delays and cancellations. After August 17, 2020, updates may occur until the start of school year as changes and updates for transportation and routes are updated daily.

Please check back frequently for updates after August 17, 2020.
