



BUS SAFETY REMINDERS

Hello Families! We hope that you are keeping safe and well as new school routines and safety measures take shape. As parents and guardians, you play a key role in supporting school bus safety.

DID YOU KNOW?

In the event that there is a COVID-19 case identified on the school bus, the vehicle seating plan is immediately submitted to the local Health Unit to support contact tracing. Where the Health Unit's investigation shows that the seating plan was not adhered to, it may mean that the entire school vehicle will be impacted by containment measures.

As bus drivers and school administration work hard to ensure that seating plans are up-to-date and upheld, we would ask that you take some time to review the importance of new or enhanced safety expectations on the school vehicle with your children, including:

- Washing/sanitizing hands prior to boarding the school vehicle
- Remaining in the assigned seat for the full duration of the ride
- Keeping masks on while entering, riding and exiting the school vehicle
- Saving snacks and treats for home
